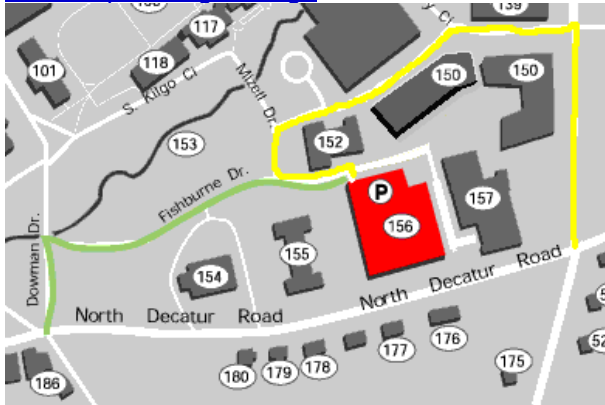


Fishburne Visitor Parking Deck - visit www.emory.edu/WWW/DIRECTIONS/fishburne.html

Directions from intersection of North Decatur and Clifton roads

Turn north onto Clifton Road. At the first light, turn left onto Fishburne Drive. At the first stop sign, bear left. Continue past the Goizueta School of Business (on your left) and bear left at the stop sign. At the next stop sign, turn left and then immediately right into the parking deck at the Visitor Parking Entrance.

Directions from Intersection of North Decatur and Oxford roads (at main entrance to Emory campus)

Turn into the Emory campus at the main entrance. Take the first right onto Fishburne Drive. Continue past Glenn Memorial United Methodist Church on your right, and the entrance to the Fishburne Visitors Parking Deck will be on your right just as you begin to go up the hill.

NOTE: If this lot is full, try the [Peavine](#) deck. See following page for directions to Peavine.

Closest to: Woodruff PE Center, **Dobbs University Center ("The DUC")**, Fraternity Row, Glenn Memorial UM Church, Sanford S. Chemistry Building (Atwood Chemistry Center), Cherry Logan Emerson Hall, and overflow undergraduate admissions parking.

Directions from westbound on North Decatur Road

Make a soft right turn onto Oxford Road. (An immediate or hard right would take you into the campus on Dowman Drive.) At next right, turn right onto campus. After the first and almost immediate stop sign, turn left at the next stop sign. The parking lot is on your left. **From eastbound on North Decatur Road**, make a hard left onto Oxford Road – follow instructions above.

Directions from Clifton Road and Asbury Drive:

Turn onto Asburn Drive and continue through the first stop sign past the old train depot (Capuccino Joe's) on your right Turn right at the second stop sign onto Fraternity Row. Continue through two more stop signs and pass the main parking deck on your right. Visitor Parking is in a ground-level lot on your right before.
