Workshop Description

On February 20, 2009, the Office of International Affairs, the Center for the Study of Public Scholarship and the Fox Center for Humanistic Inquiry will conduct an intensive workshop for faculty in the humanities and social sciences who will be applying to international funding competitions and who already have draft proposals. The workshop provides a setting where each participant can develop and polish their proposal with feedback and guidance from an interdisciplinary, experienced set of colleagues. Admission to the workshop is by application only, and participants will be selected on the basis of how well developed their proposal is and how well it fits the interdisciplinary theme of the workshop.

Time and Place

The workshop will be held at the Center for the Study of Public Scholarship for one full day on February 20, 2009 from 9:00am – 5:00pm.

How to Apply

The application coversheet can be found at www.csps.emory.edu. Email the coversheet with an 8-10 page (double-spaced) draft proposal. Please do not use a typeface smaller than 12 point. The draft proposal should have sections clearly describing:

- The research problem
- Its relation to relevant theoretical and topical literature
- The contribution your research makes to the understanding of a geographical setting and/or historical time (if this is relevant) and/or the project's other contributions
- The methods of data collection and methods of analysis you plan to use
- Your qualifications to conduct this research
- A timeline for completion of the project
- A 1-2 page bibliography of key references

Please also include a copy of your CV with your cover sheet and draft proposal.
